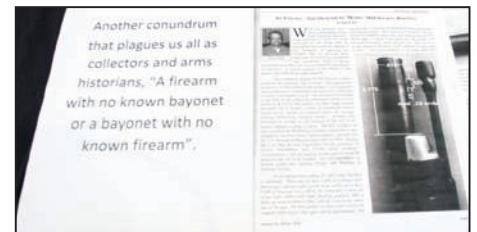
Bayonet Blade (maybe a French 1769-1771 bayonet to be fashioned in the manner of colonial shielded socket bayonet.)

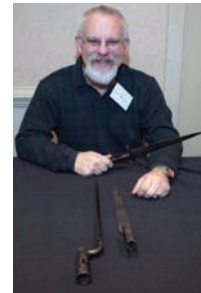

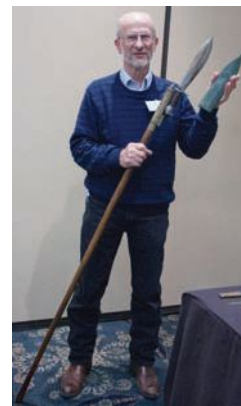

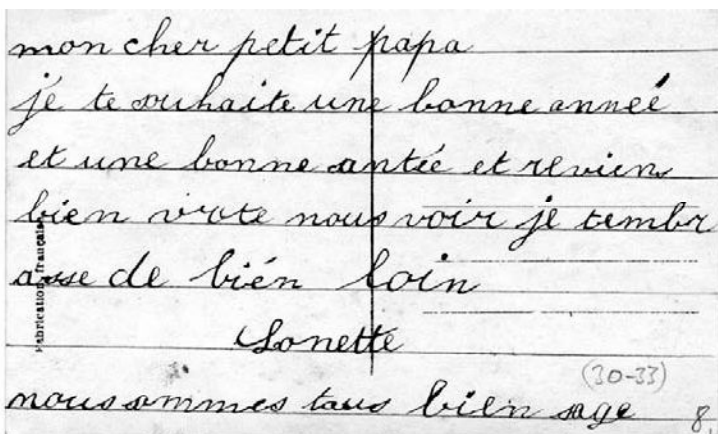
