**The Society of American Bayonet**

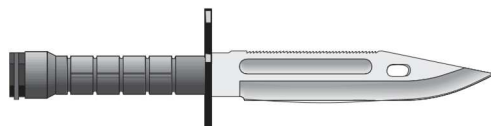

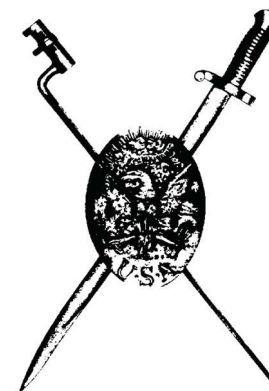
